During the next couple of weeks, we will continue to recruit teams and also look for additional donations for prizes, silent auction items, and drawings. We have some really nice items already, including fly rods, fishing gear, log furniture, guided fly fishing trips, and more. This year, we'll have craft beer and feature some live acoustic music at the banquet! Volunteers and Superfly participants will enjoy a free banquet dinner, and the banquet is also open to the public. We welcome all guests and offer dinner tickets on Saturday night for \$25.

We also recently funded a new *Adopt A Trout* program and are assisting with additional fundraising efforts to launch the program for local schools this year. GAS will be increasing our local conservation efforts this year as well, and we are excited to be partnering with *Colorado Parks & Wildlife* on a river/habitat improvement project on the Van Tuyl's stretch of the Gunnison River this fall. We have committed \$3,000 in financial support and 100 man-hours of on-the-ground labor. We are also planning to support a *Casting for Recovery (CfR)* retreat in our area in 2016. Local artist and fly fishing guide, Patrick Duke, has donated an original painting for the silent auction and all proceeds from this item will go to *CfR*.
